










THE EARLY MODEL WAS BUILT PREDOMINENTLY ON ATHLETE INTERESTS



COVID-19 BROUGHT INCREASED FOCUS ON HEALTH & WELLBEING




THE FOCUS HAS RETURNED TO A BALANCE OF RECREATIONAL & RACE SWIMMERS

VSCG GUIDING PRINCIPLES

1. FUNDAMENTALS

Great Swim experiences: Deliver a sense of freedom & Adventure

2. AWARENESS

Educate on Risk, manage risk sensibly.

3. PARTNERSHIP

Create a community to make safe swimming and the management of risk acceptable to all.

4. RESPONSIBILITY

Promote a culture of self responsibility. Expect parents and guardians to supervise people in their care.

5. RISK CONTROL

NOP, EAP's, experience, education & practice, all "behind the scenes".
